MARIE CURIE

Marie Skłodowska Curie was borne in Warsaw, Poland, on Novembar 7, 1867.

She went on to become the first women to win a Nobel Prize, winning the award with her French husbend (Pierre) in 1903.

Just 8 years later, she won another Nobel Prize and became the first person to win twice.

Marie studied radioactivity – the study of energy and particles – and found two radioactive chemicals during her reserch.

These discoveries helped Marie make X-ray mashines, used to help soldyers in World War I.
